Code of Conduct for coaches

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

Play your part and observe the BIJFL Code of Conduct in everything you do.

On and off the field, I will:

- Show respect to others involved in the game including referees, opposition players, coaches, and spectators
- Adhere to the rules and spirit of the game
- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything, including winning
- Encourage each player to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Promote Fair Play and high standards of behaviour
- Always respect the referee's decisions
- Avoid all forms of gamesmanship
- Never enter the field of play apart from to tend to an injured player
- Never engage in public criticism of the referees
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour

On match days, I will

- Arrive punctually and prepare my team to be ready for the given kick off times.
- Provide a set of coloured bibs or jerseys different to the team colours in the event of a clash of colours with and opposing team
- Carry player registration documents with me to present to the referees before kick off
- Assist with any setting up or packing away of equipment as requested by the league administrators

Should I have any problems with score lines, league rules, referees, conduct of participating bodies, or any other issue that may arise; I will report them to the league administrators outside of league playing times.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any of the following actions may be taken by my club or the BIJFL.

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club official or league administrator
- Suspended by my club from attending matches

I have read and understood the above along with the BIJFL match rules.
