Code of Conduct for Competing Organisations

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

Play your part and observe the BIJFL Code of Conduct in everything you do.

I will:

- Show respect to others involved in the game including other organisations, referees, opposition players, coaches, and spectators.
- Promote Fair Play and high standards of behavior throughout my organization.
- Respect other competing teams and refrain from actively encouraging players or coaches to transfer to my club from competing teams.
- Present the league in a positive manner to external organisations.
- Do my utmost to ensure my teams are available to play all scheduled fixtures.
- Notify the League Coordinator as soon as possible in the event of any fixturing issues or unavailability of my teams.
- Assist the BIJFL Committee and Coordinators in the smooth organization of the league.
- Ensure all players are competing in the correct age-group, and provide documentation to that effect where requested.
- Ensure my coaches, players and spectators to obey the rules and spirit of the game, respect referee's decisions and avoid all forms for gamesmanship or unsporting behaviour.

- Deal in an appropriate manner with coaches, players and spectators who do not obey the rules and spirit of the game. offensive, insulting or abusive language or behavior.
- Work to improve the competition through providing constructive feedback through the correct channels.



I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any of the following actions may be taken by my club or the BIJFL.

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal or written warning from a club official or league administrator
- Suspended or expelled from the competition, with league fees not returned.
