We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

The behaviour of the referees has an impact, directly and indirectly, on the conduct of everyone involved in the game – both on the pitch and on the sidelines.

Play your part and observe the BIJFL Code of Conduct at all times.

I will:

- Read and make sure that I understand the league rules
- Apply the league rules fairly and consistently
- Wear appropriate clothing when refereeing
- Treat the safety of the players as a priority
- Play my part in helping the players learn the rules of the game through good communication
- Be honest and completely impartial at all times
- Manage the game in a positive, calm and confident manner
- Deal with all instances of violence, aggression, unsporting behaviour, foul play and other misconduct
- Never tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour from players and officials

Referees' Match day Duties:

- Check player passport/ID card photocopies before the first match of the day
- Check players' shin guards and footwear for suitability
- Be responsible for the match ball
- Record the score of every match
- Get the signature of the coaches after each match
- Report the scores to the BIJFL administrator
- Report problems with behaviour, facilities or equipment or any other issue to the BIJFL administrator
