We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

Football should be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment.

Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. **Winning isn't everything.**

Play your part and observe the Beijing International Junior Football League Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times.

I will:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the referee's decisions
- Take up a viewing position a minimum of 10m from a goal and stand a minimum of 1m back from the touchline
- Not enter the field of play unless given permission by a referee
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition and referee
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning

- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour
- Adhere to the rules of the venue
- Not smoke on school campuses
- Only use the football and bathroom facilities of the school campuses

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club or the BIJFL.

I may be:

- Issued a verbal warning from a club or league administrator
- Obliged to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club not to attend future games
